

A smart appearance is required at all times, including travelling to and from school.

- You are a role model to younger pupils
- You represent the school when showing around visitors and parents
- You must aim to enhance the reputation of The Grange School in the community

The following dress code offers guidance, but be aware that your overall appearance is more important than the details of specific items of clothing. **As a rule of thumb, what you wear to school should be suitable attire for a customer facing business environment.**

Everyday

- A formal suit **or**
- Smart formal trousers/skirt with a smart formal top or collared shirt and blazer **or**
- A smart formal dress with a blazer
- Shoes must be appropriate for wearing with a suit in a professional workplace.

Additional Guidance

- Trousers, dresses and skirts must of an appropriate length and not be too revealing. Jeans and shorts are not permitted. For guidance on skirt/dress length, if your hands are by your sides, your skirt/dress should be below your fingertips.
- Strappy tops are not permitted. All tops should cover the midriff and not be too revealing. Polo shirts are not permitted.
- If students do not wish to wear a tie, they must be wearing a blazer or a smart $\frac{3}{4}$ zip
- If students do not wish to wear their blazer, their shoulders must be covered.
- Trainers are not acceptable.
- Smart jumpers and cardigans are permitted provided they do not have a large logo. Sweatshirts and hoodies are not acceptable.
- Hair must be neat and of a natural colour.
- A blazer can be replaced with a smart formal outdoor jacket.
- Outer coats can be worn to and from school, but must only be worn around the school site when it is raining.

The final decision as to what constitutes an appropriate appearance, rests with The School.
